Re: Use of Biobor JF aviation fuel additive in Northern Ireland - EU BPR

This letter is to advise suppliers and users of Biobor JF that the current Critical Situation Permit issued by HSE(GB) will expire on 30th October 2024.

HSENI as the enforcing authority for the Biocidal Product Regulation EC (No) 528/2012, will permit the continued supply and use for Biobor JF as a biocidal product for controlling microbiological contamination in aircraft fuel systems after this date in Northern Ireland where its use is deemed essential for the safe operation of aircraft.

It will be permitted to be supplied and used in Northern Ireland subject to all measures as detailed in the product safety data sheet being adhered to by all users.

This arrangement will continue until such times as the European Commission makes a decision on the current application for a 550-day Article 55(1) derogation, or the product is granted full authorisation as a biocidal product.
